Research Proposal Summary:

Modifications to the computer room at Narrabri Research Station were undertaken in 1985 to provide closer control of dust levels, room temperature and humidity (Cotton Research Council, project DAN 24L). The building modifications greatly reduced the space previously used for the permanent location of computer terminals, requiring alternative arrangements to be made.

As no other room was available in the Administration Building, most of the terminals were set up to operate from individual work places in offices and laboratories. It was expected that portable terminals would also have the advantage of permitting a continuity of work effort by avoiding the disruption and distractions which can arise when a user moves between office/laboratory and a central terminal location.

Funds were sought through this project to enable the purchase of six portable video display terminals to service cotton research projects being carried out by Officers of the Department of Agriculture located at Narrabri. At the time of application (1985/86) there were eight such projects supported by grants totalling \$167,400.

FINAL REPORT: Additional terminals for VAX 11/750 computer. (Project DAN 23L).

The Administration Building at Narrabri Research Station was wired to allow connections to the VAX to be made from all offices and laboratories. Links were also provided to three laboratories located outside the building.

Six VT220-ZC terminals were supplied by Digital Equipment Corporation in February 1986. One was located in the insectary, one in the computer room and the remainder were set up on mobile work stations in the Administration Building.

The system has worked faultlessly to date and has proven to be an efficient alternative to the permanent central location of all terminals. A service contract for the terminals is currently being negotiated with Digital Equipment Corporation. The cost is expected to be \$950 p.a.

The total cost of the project was \$8784
