Mobile devices are everywhere. Smart phones are more than just something to make calls with, and tablets have revolutionised the way that we work and play.

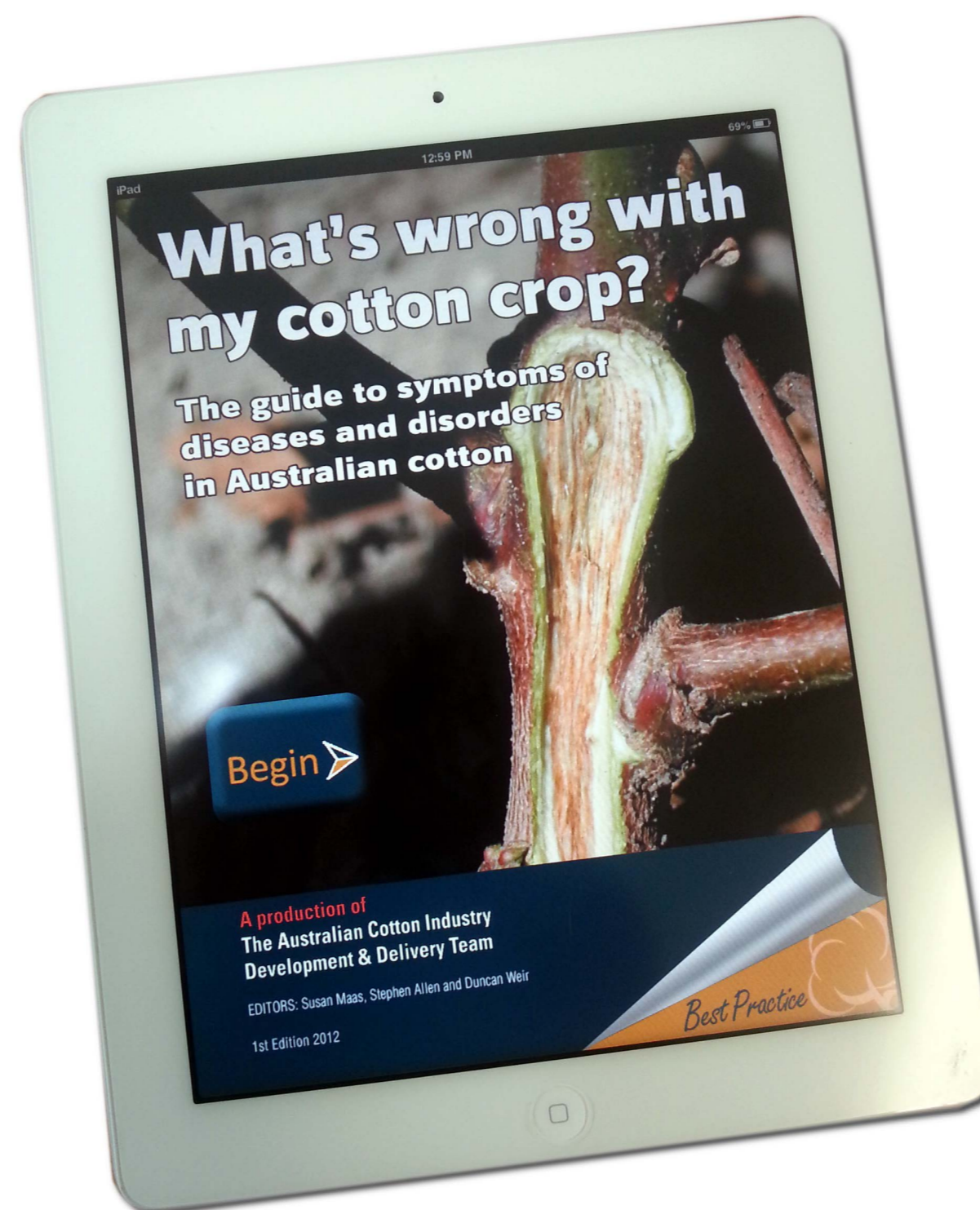
A library worth of books can be stored and read on mobile devices and it is changing the format in which information is shared.

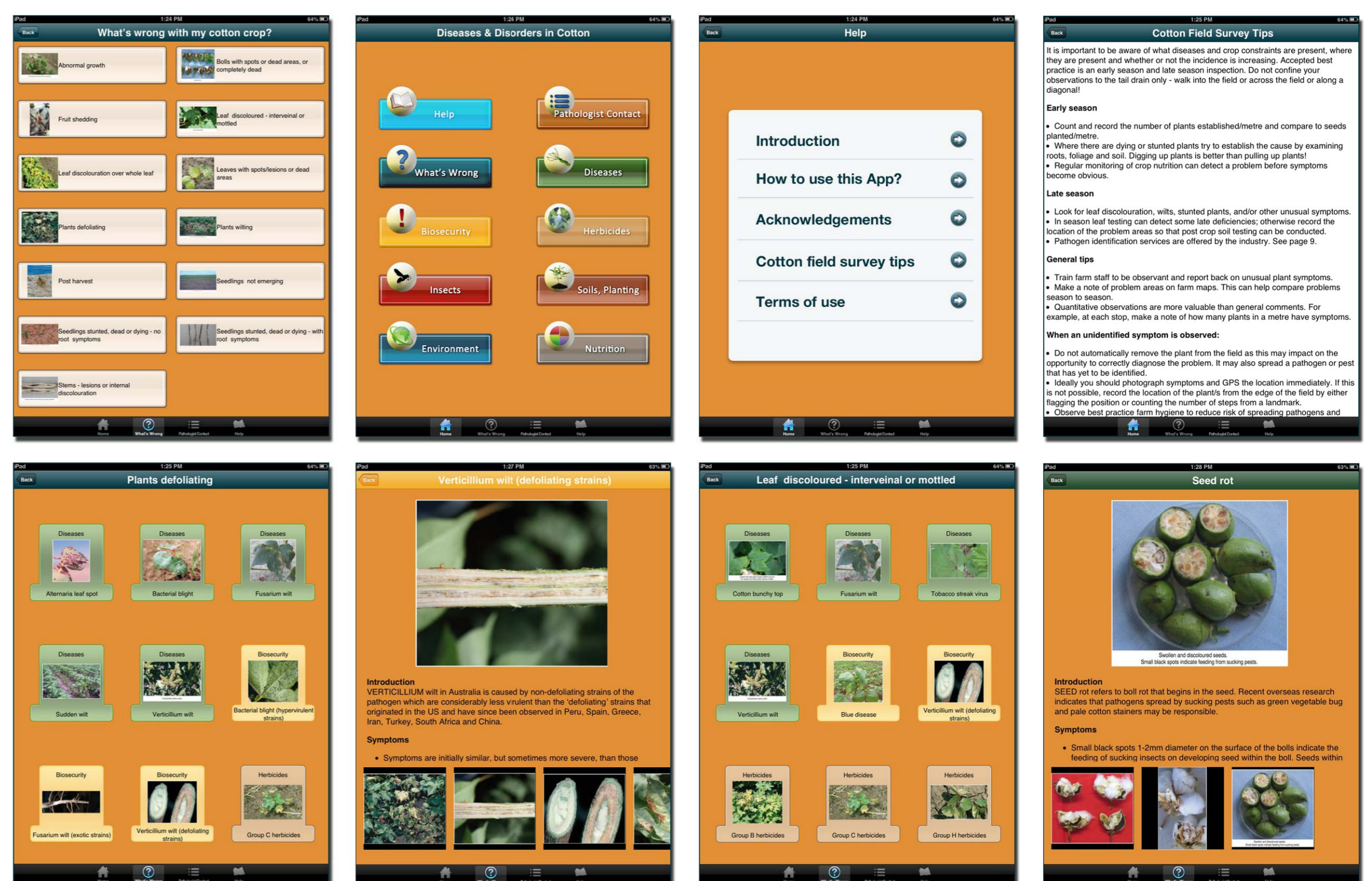
