

# Community Partnerships - PCYC Friday Night Freestyle

NSW Transport committed funding to enable Youth from outlying areas to attend Friday Night Freestyle Activities at the Moree PCYC. To enable this program to go ahead it was necessary for the community to take the lead.

Meetings were held with identified key stakeholders and an MOU was developed, which aligned effort strategically for outreach inclusion into the program.

The program aims to deter Youth from risk taking behaviours and provide Youth aged 11-17 years, with access to social activities that encourage Healthy Life Choices.

This has connected services and NGO's with community based groups such as the Wee Waa Sports Incorporated Committee.

This will enable the program to be utilised as an evidence based approach to sourcing funds to develop Youth and Community programs within the Wee Waa community.
